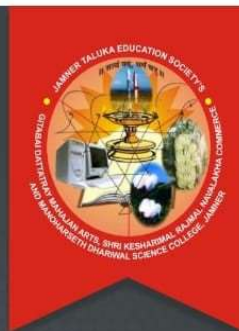

It is a unique institution in this Taluka, imparting instructions from Undergraduate to Post Graduate courses including Professional courses. Following are the salient features of the College.

2.0 STUDENTS SUPPORT SERVICES :

2.1 COLLEGE BUILDING :- At present the College is being run in its own building near Bus Stand, Jalgaon Road.

2.2 GIRLS' HOSTEL :- A well furnished and isolated hostel building with adequate facilities is available in the campus for the girl students. The girl students are expected to take benefit of this facility for their educational upliftment. For the detailed information, contact the Office Administration.

2.3 LABORATORIES :- Well equipped laboratories are available for Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Geography & Computer Science Departments

2.4 Student E Suvidha Center :- From this Academic year new Facility of online E Suvidha Center is started for students to fill up university admission form and examination form in college premises lot of labour will be saved of student.

2.5 CENTRAL LIBRARY :- Central Library is the heart of the institution. The Library is rich with **36810** books inclusive of **26990** reference & other sources with **10032** text-books, Journals & Periodicals back issues 1909 bound volumes, **02** Periodicals with various subjects. e-services, INFLIBNET-N-List, 72 users are taking advantage of this facility. Similarly Competitive Exam Books, Journals, Periodicals, New-papers, alongwith local & National level are available for students and learners. The library working process is completely computerised. Internet facility is also available for advanced learners and researchers. Student borrow two books every week on payment of library deposits. In addition to this there is a separate Book- Bank section having **2606** books, which provides text-books to poor & needy students free of cost for whole years. Similarly provides for students, zerox, book searching, separate reading room facility with this central library is assisting to the departmental libraries of all the major departments

2.6 GYMKHANA :- The sport facilities are provided to the students. Facilities for indoor games and outdoor games like Cricket, Holly-ball, Kabaddi are also made available. Our students participate in intercollegiate, Intergroup and Inter-University & Inter-State Tournaments & excel in various games.

2.7 HEALTH CLUB :- Well equipped Health Club is available for daily exercise & body building for students. A special instructor is appointed for Health Club, who looks after all these activities.

2.8 COMPUTER CENTRE :- There are two separate computer laboratories for Computer Science & Commerce Department each having **50** computers with Internet facility.

2.9 TEACHING & LEARNING : WE PROMOTE

2.12 STUDENTS GRIEVANCE CELL

The college has established Students' Grievance Cell to solve academic problems and difficulties of students. Complaints from students are put to the said committee which takes cognizance at the very moment and solution is provided.

2.13 STUDENTS' COUNCIL

As per the guidelines of North Maharashtra University, Students' Council is formed every year. A class representative, according to merit, represent the class. These representative elects University Representative. Members of Students' Council participate in various activities in the college.

2.14 YASHWANTRAO CHAVAN MAHARASHTRA OPEN UNIVERSITY, NASHIK

The well established and well furnished study centre of YCMOU Nasik is run by the college since 2007. preparatory courses as well as First / Second /Third year B.A. courses are available.

S.S.C./ H.S.C. fail students can complete the Preparatory Course and thereafter get admission to First Year Arts Degree Course.

2.15 PLACEMENT CELL

Placement and Counselling Cell is working from 2010, successfully headed by Science faculties. Main aim of this cell is to provide opportunities to the undergraduate / post graduate students for their employment. This year (i) Vega Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. Jalgaon (ii) Navkisan Agro Products Ltd. Aurangabad (iii) Training and Placement Cell of North Maharashtra University Jalgaon has selected 12 students for training & placement. Cell also conducts personality development programmes to upgrade students' soft skills. From this year, our placement cell has tied-up with the TPC of North Maharashtra University Jalgaon.

2.16 COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION GUIDANCE CELL

Under Graduate and Post Graduate students from the entry level are motivated towards the pattern for MPSC / UPSC as well other competitive examinations through arranging the lectures of eminent personalities from outside as well arranging the examination on holidays serially.

2.17 REMEDIAL COURSES

The college conducts Courses for slow learners and for the students coming from weaker section of the society. Students are satisfactorily gained from these courses.

2.18 ASSESSMENT FOR FEEDBACK

Being Teaching & Learning is the continuous process, evaluation of the student is the part and parcel of quality education. Test, Tutorials, Home Assignments, Seminars, Group Discussions are used as methods of assessing the students. coming from weaker section of the society. Students are satisfactorily gained from these courses.

2.19 YUVATI SABHA

This activity is specially formed to guide the girl students. Through out the year variety of programmes arranged for their health and hygiene, responsibilities and their rights, personality development. Social activist, Doctors, Lawyers are invited for casual lecturers and guidance.

2.20 RESEARCH CENTRE UNDER U.G.C. SCHEME :- A Research Centre under U.G.C. Scheme as guidelines of the U.G.C. for guiding the Researchers. Teachers recognised by the University guide the students and researchers for their research work for M.Phil. & Ph.D. 50% of the staff members are carrying out Minor Research Projects funded by U.G.C. Some teachers are deputed on FIP for Ph.D. degree.

2.21 NATIONAL CADET CORPS [N.C.C.] :- N.C.C. facility is available in the college under 18th Mah.Bat. Jalgaon, intake capacity is 34 cadets. Cadets will get different scholarships.

2.22 NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME [N.S.S.] :- N.S.S. unit is available in the college, N.M.U. granted 200 students in this scheme.

2.23 MEDICAL CHECK-UP :- Every year students admitted at First Year level have to go for Medical Check-up. The Expert & experienced Doctors from the town held up the Medical Check-up.

2.24 STUDENTS WELFARE PROGRAMME :- English Literary Association, Commerce Association, Competitive Exam Guidance Centre, Debate Association, Placement Centre, Nature Club & Geography Association, Science Association, Planning Association, Yuvati Sabha, Cultural Association etc. work through-out the year. To nurture hidden qualities of the students, time to time, supportive activities are being conducted in the college.

2.25 ALUMNI ASSOCIATION :- Alumni Association is established for ex-students. It is expected to involve maximum number of ex-students in the development of college activities & to help new college students.

2.26 STUDENTS AID FUND :- Under this scheme financially poor, intelligent and needy students are given financial help by the college.

2.27 ANNUAL MAGAZINE 'MAKARAND' :-

Every year college annual magazine 'Makarand' is published. Full exposure of students qualities in various fields of curricular and extra- curricular activities are given space in this magazine. Glimpses of events, articles, projects carried out by teachers and achievement of the staff as well is published in it.

2.28 JAMNER TALUKA VIDYAN PRASAR SAMITI, JAMNER.

This is a science forum of all the science teachers, lecturers, working in Jamner Taluka Education Society. Along with this, the science teachers in all the nearby High Schools, Junior Colleges are also the members of this committee.

The aim of this Samiti is " **organisation of events is awareness.**" To achieve this goal the committee organizes the programmes like "science-week" every year, The informative science lectures are delivered by science lecturers at different high schools and Junior Colleges. From last year "Eco-Friendly Ganesh-Utsav" workshop is now going to organize every year for all the Ganesh Mandals for Urban and Rural area to aware the society for Green aspect.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY : F.Y.B.A/ F.Y.B.Com. / F.Y.B.Sc.

According to North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon Circular No.74/1995, students seeking admission at First year B.A./ B.Com. / B.Sc. must have passed 10+2 level H.S.C. examination (Std. XII) or any other equivalent examination with English.

Students passing D.Ed. with English as one of the subject can have an admission at F.Y.B.A. Whereas a student passing Diploma in Engineering can seek an admission at F.Y.B.Com. Other criteria, terms and conditions for admission as per the K.B.C.N.M.University, Jalgaon

" No student can seek an admission on Duplicate L.C. & T.C."

3.1 S.Y./T.Y.B.A./B.Com /B.Sc./ M.A./M.COM/M.Sc.

1] Students seeking admission at S.Y./T.Y.B.A./B.Com. /B.Sc./ M.A./M.COM/M.Sc. must take an admission within **10 days** from the declaration of the result of the previous examination. Students are required to attach a **xerox copy of Mark Statement of the previous examination** to his / her admission form.

2] As per North Maharashtra University Circular No.32/1995, a student passing degree examination from the other Universities can not seek admission for other degree courses available in N.M.U., Jalgaon.

3] Minimum 5 students are required to opt for Special & General Subjects. Hon. Principal of the college reserves the right to continue & conduct the same class if the required number of admission are not available.

- १) प्रथम वर्ष कला या वर्गात प्रवेश घेवु ईच्छिणाऱ्या विद्यार्थ्यांना विद्यापिठांने दिलेल्या विविध गृपस मधुन एकुण आठ विषयांची निवड करणे आवश्यक आहे.
- २) मुख्य विषय ज्यांना NEP 2020 नुसार Major 1, Major 2, Major 3, (M1, M2, M3) संबोधले जाते या तीन विषयाची निवड करण्यासाठी दोन गृप करण्यात आलेले आहेत. Marathi, Hindi, व English या भाषा विषयांचा एक गट तयार करण्यात आलेला आहे. त्याला Language Group संबोधले जाते. तसेच Economice, Geography, Political Science, Sociology, Psychology, History आणि Home Economice या विषयांचा दुसरा गृप तयार करण्यात आलेला आहे. त्याला Social Sciences Group संबोधले जाते. विद्यापिठ नियमानुसार विद्यार्थ्यांना भाषा विषयांच्या गटातुन कमीत कमी एक व जास्तीत जास्त दोन भाषा विषयांची निवड करता येईल परंतु जर त्या विद्यार्थ्याने भाषा विषयांची एकच विषयाची निवड केली तर त्या विद्यार्थ्याला Social Sciences गृप मधुन दोन विषयांची निवड करता येईल आणि भाषा विषयांची निवड केली तर Social Sciences गृप मधुन फक्त एकाच विषयाची निवड करता येईल या तत्वानुसार जर विद्यार्थ्याने विषयांची निवड केली नाही तर पात्रते संबंधी अडचणी निर्माण होतात. याची विद्यार्थ्यांनी गांभिर्याने नोंद घ्यावी.

5. विद्यार्थी कल्याण मंडळाच्या योजना —

उत्तर महाराष्ट्र विद्यापीठाने विद्यार्थ्यांसाठी राबविलेल्या विविध योजना

5.1 कर्मवीर भाउराव पाटील कमवा व शिका योजना —

कर्मवीर भाउराव पाटील कमवा व शिका ही पदवी व पदव्युत्तर शिक्षण घेणा—या विद्यार्थ्यांसाठी आहे, तसेच आर्थिकदृष्ट्या दुर्बल घटक, होतकरु व गरजू विद्यार्थ्यांच्या उच्च शिक्षणासाठी ही योजना आहे. या योजनेचा उद्देश स्वावलंबनाने विद्याथ्याला श्रमाची आवड निर्माण करणे, श्रमाची प्रतिष्ठा वाढविणे, स्वयंरोजगारासाठी विद्यार्थ्यांना प्रवृत्त करणे आदि मुख्य उद्देश योजनेचे आहेत. योजनेत विद्यार्थ्यांनी अध्ययनाच्या वेळेव्यतिरिक्त किमान तीन तास काम करणे अपेक्षित आहे. या योजनेद्वारे विद्यार्थ्यांना आर्थिक लाभ मिळतो.

5.2 साहस कार्यशाळा —

विद्यार्थ्यांना साहसीवृत्ती निर्माण होणेविषयी या कार्यशाळेत प्रशिक्षण व मार्गदर्शन दिले जाते. संकटांना धैर्याने सामोरे जाणे, मार्ग काढणे, मदत करणे, गिर्यारोहण, रोपवे, पुल बांधणी, रस्ता दुरुस्ती, दिशा ओळख, आकाश, निरीक्षण, आत्मसंरक्षण व प्रतिकार आणि निसर्ग सहल असे विविध उपक्रम राबविण्यात येत असतात. प्रत्येक महाविद्यालयातील १ विद्यार्थी व १ विद्यार्थिनी या कार्यशाळेत सहभागी होवू शकतात.

5.3 डॉ.बाबासाहेब आंबेडकर वसतिगृह विद्यार्थी सहाय्यता योजना —

विद्यापीठाच्या शैक्षणिक प्रशाळा अथवा विभागांमध्ये पदवी, पदव्युत्तर अभ्यासक्रमासाठी नियमित प्रवेश व विद्यापीठाच्या वसतिगृहात निवासित विद्यार्थ्यांपैकी जे आर्थिकदृष्ट्या कमकुवत असलेल्या होतकरु विद्यार्थ्यांना आर्थिकसहाय्य उपलब्ध करून देण्याच्या दृष्टीने डॉ.बाबासाहेब आंबेडकर वसतिगृह विद्यार्थी सहाय्यता योजना कार्यान्वित करण्यात आली आहे.

5.4 उमवि संचलित चाणक्य स्पर्धा परीक्षा —

विद्यार्थ्यांमधील स्पर्धा परीक्षा कौशल्य वृद्धिंगत करणेसाठी व पूर्वतयारीसाठी महाविद्यालयीन विद्यार्थ्यांसाठी विद्यापीठ स्तरावर चाणक्य स्पर्धा परीक्षा एकाच दिवशी आयोजित करण्यात येते. प्रत्येक महाविद्यालय हे परीक्षा केंद्र आहे. ५० पेक्षा जास्त परीक्षार्थी असलेल्या महाविद्यालयांना पूर्व तयारीसाठी स्पर्धा परीक्षांसाठी अनुदान देण्यात येते. उत्तीर्ण विद्यार्थ्यांना प्रशस्तीपत्रक देण्यात येतील. स्थानिक महाविद्यालयातील विद्यार्थी कल्याण अधिकारी हे या उपक्रमाचे प्रमुख असतील. तलाठी, पी.एस.आय., तहसीलदार या पदांसाठीच्या स्पर्धा परीक्षेची तयारी या उपक्रमाद्वारे होईल. सदर परीक्षेत महाविद्यालयातील कितीही विद्यार्थी सहभागी होवू शकतात.

5.5 उमवि विद्यार्थी दत्तक योजना —

विद्यापीठ विभागातील विविध प्रशाळा व शैक्षणिक विभाग यातील शिक्षण घेणा—या गरजू व होतकरु विद्यार्थ्यांसाठी विद्यार्थी कल्याण विभागाच्यावतीने शैक्षणिक वर्ष २०११-१२ पासून उमवि विद्यार्थी दत्तक योजना सुरु करण्यात आली आहे. त्यासाठी १० विद्यार्थी व १० विद्यार्थिनी यांना योजनेचा लाभ देण्यात येतो.

5.6 विद्यार्थी संशोधन योजना —

संशोधनाला प्रोत्साहन देण्यासाठी, संशोधक विद्यार्थी अडचणीमुळे मागे राहू नये यासाठी संशोधक विद्यार्थ्यांसाठी विद्यापीठाद्वारे भरीव आर्थिक तरतूद करण्यात आली आहे. विद्यापीठाचे विभाग व संलग्नीत महाविद्यालये यांचेसाठी संशोधन विकास योजना आहे. विद्यार्थी कल्याण विभाग अंतर्गत विद्यार्थी संशोधन प्रोत्साहन योजना, मा.कुलगुरु प्रायोजित विशेष संशोधन योजना विज्ञान व तंत्रज्ञान विषयात विशेष कार्य करणा—या विद्यार्थ्यांस जी.एच. रायसोनी यांचे सौजन्याने तीन संशोधक विद्यार्थ्यांना ७,०००/- ते रु. १०,०००/- पर्यंत प्रतिमाह संशोधन शिष्यवृत्ती दिली जाते.

5.7 सांस्कृतिक गुण कार्यशाळा आयोजन —

विद्यार्थ्यांना गायन, वादन, नृत्य, नाट्य, सुत्रसंचलन, कार्यशाळा या क्षेत्रातील नव्या संकल्पना, तंत्रज्ञान अवगत व्हावे त्यांची सांस्कृतिक क्षेत्रातील प्रगती व्हावी यासाठी कार्यशाळांचे आयोजन विद्यापीठ स्तरावर विद्यार्थी कल्याण विभाग करते.

5.8 युवती सभा कार्यशाळा —

विद्यार्थी कल्याण विभागामार्फत नियमित शिक्षण घेणा—या विद्यार्थिनींकरिता महाविद्यालयीन स्तरावर विशेष स्वरूपाच्या उपक्रमांचे आयोजन करणेकरिता युवती सभा अंतर्गत स्वयंसिध्दा—अभियान व विद्यार्थिनी व्यक्तिमत्व विकास कार्यशाळा आयोजित करण्यात येते. प्रत्येक कार्यशाळेत महाविद्यालयातील ५० विद्यार्थिनी सहभागी होवू शकतात.

5.9 एकलव्य विद्याधन कर्ज योजना —

एकलव्य विद्याधन कर्ज योजना ही पदवी व पदव्युत्तर शिक्षण घेणा—या विद्यार्थ्यांसाठी आहे. योजनेत विद्यार्थ्यांना शिक्षणासाठी येणा—या खर्चाच्या ७० टक्के रक्कम कर्ज स्वरूपात आवश्यक त्या कागदपत्रांच्या पूर्ततेनंतर बँकेद्वारे उपलब्ध आहे. शिक्षण कर्जासाठी व्याजाचा दर द.सा.द.शे.११ टक्के असेल. शिक्षण कालावधीमधील खर्चाच्या व्याजाची रक्कम विद्यापीठ कार्यालयाद्वारे अदा केली जाते. ज्या विद्यार्थ्यास प्रवेशित काळात शासकीय/ निमशासकीय/सहकारी संस्था/ बँका यांच्याकडून कोणतेही विद्यावेतन/ शिष्यवृत्ती मिळत नसेल, असाच विद्यार्थी या योजनेचा लाभ घेण्यासाठी पात्र राहील.

5.10 मा.कुलगुरु वैद्यकिय निधी योजना —

विद्यार्थी सामुहिक सुरक्षा योजनेशिवाय अपघाती /नैसर्गिक मृत्यू झाल्यास रु.५,०००/ —मृत विद्यार्थ्यांच्या पालकास मा.कुलगुरु वैद्यकिय निधीतून देण्यात येतील. प्रवेशित विद्यार्थ्यास एखादा गंभीर आजार, अपघाताने जखमी झाल्यास उपचारासाठी योग्य त्या कागदपत्रांची खातजमा करून सहाय्य करण्यात येते.

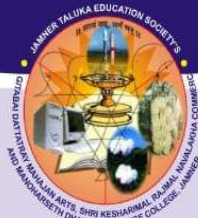
